

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT:

- 1.** No verbal or physical abuse is permitted towards ANY child (that includes your own), coach, parent, or referee.
- 2.** All parents are expected to treat their wrestler, coaches, opponents, opponent's coaches, parents, and referees with respect.
- 3.** All parents are expected to follow State Law by not using tobacco products while on any school property for practices, camps, or tournaments.
- 4.** Parents will be allowed to observe the practice room remotely from a TV located in the meeting room of the practice facility. Only parents with USAW/IKWF coaches' cards that have been approved by the Bulls WC board will be allowed in the room to help with practice.
- 5.** Parents are expected to keep their other children from disrupting practice while at the facility. Parents may be responsible for any damages that their child has caused to the facility.
- 6.** No shoes are allowed in the practice room unless they are wrestling shoes.
- 7.** Please make sure your wrestler goes home and bathes/showers immediately after practice to help minimize risk of contagious skin infections like ringworm, impetigo, staph, etc. If your wrestler has an infectious skin infection, please keep him out of practices until they are cleared by a doctor to prevent spreading it to other wrestlers.
- 8.** Respect your athlete. This is their sport and season. Don't relive your athletic career through them. Let them learn and compete for themselves.
- 9.** Have fun! This is an exciting sport. Remember that these kids are kids. They are learning the sport. If you are enjoying yourself, they will be more likely to enjoy it even more. They need your encouragement and positive behavior.
